Title: Proposed Additions to ISO/IEC 10646 Source: U.S. National Body (INCITS/L2)

This document describes additions to ISO/IEC 10646 that the U.S. National body would like to see integrated in the standard. The items in this category are considered mature enough for inclusion in the standard. We recommend all of the following be targeted for inclusion in the 4th edition.

1. Latin Extended-E

The U.S. requests the addition of the following 4 characters with glyphs and properties as given in WG2 N4213:

U+AB60 LATIN SMALL LETTER SAKHA IOTIFIED A
U+AB61 LATIN SMALL LETTER IOTIFIED E
U+AB62 LATIN SMALL LETTER OPEN OE
U+AB63 LATIN SMALL LETTER UO

2. Miscellaneous Symbols and Arrows

The U.S. requests the addition of the following 4 characters with glyphs and properties as given in WG2 N4318:

U+2BEC LEFTWARDS TWO-HEADED ARROW WITH TRIANGLE ARROWHEADS
U+2BED UPWARDS TWO-HEADED ARROW WITH TRIANGLE ARROWHEADS
U+2BEE RIGHTWARDS TWO-HEADED ARROW WITH TRIANGLE ARROWHEADS
U+2BEF DOWNWARDS TWO-HEADED ARROW WITH TRIANGLE ARROWHEADS

The names differ from those proposed in WG2 N4318.

3. Miscellaneous Symbols and Pictographs

The U.S. requests the addition of U+1F54F BOWL OF HYGIEIA, with glyph and properties as given in WG2 N4393.

4. Cyrillic Extended-B

The U.S. requests the addition of U+A69E COMBINING CYRILLIC LETTER EF, with glyph and properties as given in WG2 N4390.
