Title: Notification of an error and a request for a correction regarding mapping information for a particular JIS X 0213 character in CJK UNIFIED IDEOGRAPHS EXTENSION-B

Japanese National Body for SC2 recently found an editorial, but serious, error in the mapping information for a particular JIS X 0213 character in CJK UNIFIED IDEOGRAPHS EXTENSION-B to be included in the forthcoming ISO/IEC 10646-2:2001. The error is caused by a mistake of Japanese National Body, and IRG is not liable for it.

The character is 2-94-5 in JIS X 0213's notation or J4-7E25 in IRG/UCS's notation. It is currently mapped to U+00029FCE by a mistake, but should be mapped to U+00029FD7.

Although it is very late in the IS development stage, Japan proposes to correct it as an editorial change before the initial publication, to minimize possible impact for users.
