1 Introduction

The Pau Cin Hau alphabet (U+11AC0..11AFF) was proposed for encoding in document WG2 N4017 L2/11-104 and accepted by the UTC during meeting #127 in May 2011. A revision of the proposal containing changes to the names of some characters was submitted (L2/11-104R). However, the names list for Pau Cin Hau that appears in the draft repertoire for PDAM 1.2 (WG2 N4107) uses the older names. It is requested that the new names be used instead.

2 Proposed Changes

The table below shows the names as given in N4107 and the new names requested:

The names for 11AC5 and 11ACA were changed to reflect modern phonology and Latin orthography for Tedim. New names for glottal-stop marks are better descriptors of the character's properties and usage. The new name for 11AF1 is a correction.
