  - Free hot and cold drinks will be available from the floor kitchen

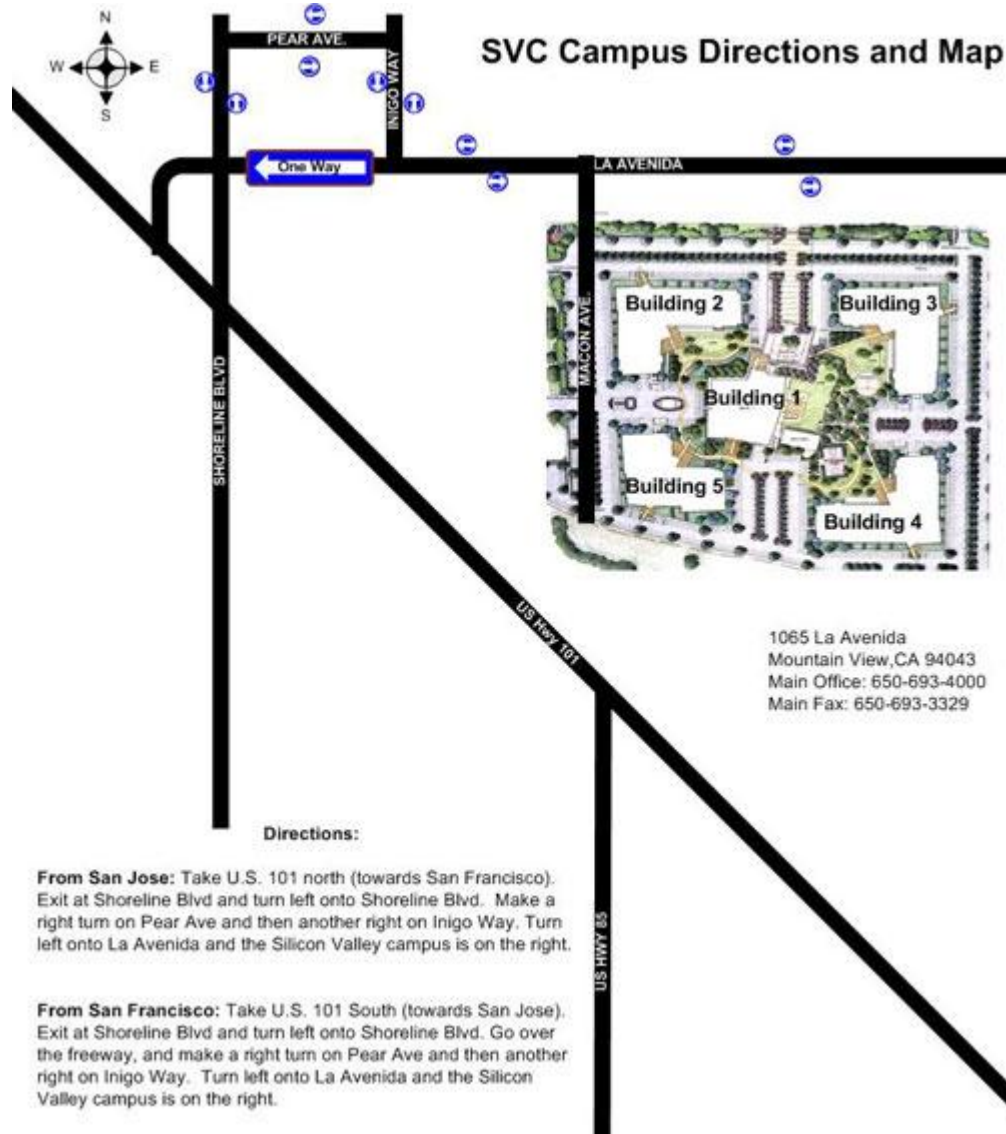
## Registration

**Getting to Mountain View, CA from San Francisco Airport (SFO) or San Jose Airport (SJC):**

All major rental companies have offices at SFO and SJC

Door to door shuttle buses are also available at both airports and cost \$30/person from SFO to Mountain View and \$25/person from SJC to Mountain View (companions pay \$10 each). Taxis will run approximately \$100 from SFO and \$50 from San Jose.
