Title: Future Additions to ISO/IEC 10646

This document describes additions to ISO/IEC 10646 that the U.S. National Body would like to see integrated in the standard. The items in this category are considered mature enough for inclusion in the standard. We recommend all of the following be targeted for inclusion in a future edition or amendment.

1. Gujarati

The U.S. requests the addition of 0AF9 GUJARATI LETTER ZHA with glyph and properties as given in WG2 N4473.

2. Arabic Extended-A

The U.S. requests the addition of the following three characters in the Arabic Extended-A block, with glyphs and properties as given in WG2 N4474:

08B3 ARABIC LETTER AIN WITH THREE DOTS BELOW

08B4 ARABIC LETTER KAF WITH DOT BELOW

08E3 ARABIC TURNED DAMMA BELOW

3. Combining Half Marks

The U.S. requests the addition of the following two characters in the Combining Half Marks block, with glyphs and properties as given in WG2 N4475:

FE2E COMBINING CYRILLIC TITLO LEFT HALF

FE2F COMBINING CYRILLIC TITLO RIGHT HALF
